

## **HSE 2013 National Service Plan Highlights (see page 17 of the Plan):**

- Mental health service budget of €733 million, representing 5.5% of the overall health budget (a slight proportional increase) and a 3.1% nominal increase on the 2012 allocation
- Commitment to completing 2012 investment programme appointment of 414 posts
- Additional 477 posts allocated for 2013 (see detailed table below)
- Planned reduction of a minimum of 102 acute inpatient beds
- New forensic mental hospital will be progressed in capital programme 2013
- In terms of other capital expenditure, a broad commitment to continue to "deliver the mental health investment programme in line with *A Vision for Change*"

It is noteworthy that the HSE states that 'budgetary pressures' were the cause of the failure to spend the €35 million allocated in 2012. The €35 million investment planned for 2013 is "subject to affordability".

The mental health services suffered a loss of 432 staff during 2012, from a position at the start of January 2012 of 9,207 to a position in December 2012 of 8,775.

## Performance targets for 2013:

- The CAMHS targets of 70% of new referrals seen within 3 months and no child waiting more than 12 months are the same as the 2012 targets. This is in a context where referrals in 2012 were 17% up on the previous year.
- The adult admissions target of 14,000 is in line with the actual number of admissions for 2012.
- The adult involuntary admissions target is increased by 18% to 1,642 and this reflects the actual number of adults expected to have been involuntarily admitted in 2012.
- The Plan contains a commitment for the first time to develop performance targets for adult community mental health services and for old age psychiatry services, though these are not specified.
- The plan anticipates a 15% increase in the number of new referrals that will be offered an appointment and seen by CAMHS teams compared to the actual figures for 2012.
